DURATION OF SAFARI

The average safaris are 7-14-21 days.

Experience has taught us that most hunters try to do too much in to short a period. Once we have a list of the animals you wish to hunt, we will suggest how much time you might need.

All safaris are carefully planned to meet the exact requirements of each individual and are normally booked well in advance. There is no specific hunting season, but March to September is the most popular time. You have a choice of hunts; or we will tailor your safari specifically according to your trophy priorities.

 Observer (Non Hunters) \$ 200 per day.
 10 days minimum Safari for Lion or Leopard.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

50% of the daily rate to confirm a safari.
 Traveller cheques or cash accepted.

CANCELLATION:

No refund but hunt can be taken in alternate year if arranged at least 30 days prior to the commencement of the Safari.

PLEASE NOTE:

Trophy fees are payable on all animals bagged or wounded. Species not listed can be made available if arranged prior to commencement of safari.
 Clients will at all times hunt at their own risk.

Services of a licensed professional hunter, trackers and skinners.
